Please note: If more students have selected a project than there are vacant places, priority rules apply: <http://kisd.de/1302.html?&lang=en>. As an incoming (exchange or MEDes) student you have top priority to take part in the courses you wish to take.

All students at KISD get ECTS for their projects, seminars and courses. The European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS) was introduced in 1989, within the framework of Erasmus. ECTS is the only credit system which has been successfully tested and used across Europe.

ECTS is based on the principle that 60 credits measure the workload of a full-time student during one academic year. The student workload of a full-time study program in Europe amounts in most cases to around 1,800 hours per year and in those cases one credit stands for around 30 working hours.
